1 AMEND House Bill No. 1637, Page 1, Section A, Line 2, by inserting after said section and line the  
2 following:

3  
4 "43.650. 1. The patrol shall, subject to appropriation, maintain a web page on the internet  
5 which shall be open to the public and shall include a registered sexual offender and registered  
6 violent offender search capability.

7 2. Except as provided in subsections 4 and 5 of this section, the registered sexual offender  
8 and registered violent offender search shall make it possible for any person using the internet to  
9 search for and find the information specified in subsection 4 of this section, if known, on offenders  
10 registered in this state pursuant to sections 589.400 to 589.425 or section 589.437.

11 3. The registered sexual offender and registered violent offender search shall include the  
12 capability to search for sexual offenders by name, by zip code, and by typing in an address and  
13 specifying a search within a certain number of miles radius from that address. The search shall also  
14 have the capability to filter results by sexual offenders or violent offenders.

15 4. Only the information listed in this subsection shall be provided to the public in the  
16 registered sexual offender and registered violent offender search:

17 (1) The name and any known aliases of the offender;

18 (2) The date of birth and any known alias dates of birth of the offender;

19 (3) A physical description of the offender;

20 (4) The residence, temporary, work, and school addresses of the offender, including the  
21 street address, city, county, state, and zip code;

22 (5) Any photographs of the offender;

23 (6) A physical description of the offender's vehicles, including the year, make, model, color,  
24 and license plate number;

25 (7) The nature and dates of all offenses qualifying the offender to register, including the tier  
26 level assigned to the offender under sections 589.400 to 589.425;

27 (8) The date on which the offender was released from the department of mental health,  
28 prison, or jail[;] or placed on parole, supervised release, or probation for the offenses qualifying the  
29 offender to register;

30 (9) Compliance status of the sexual or violent offender with the provisions of [~~section~~]

2 (10) Any online identifiers, as defined in section 43.651, used by the person. Such online  
3 identifiers shall not be included in the general profile of an offender on the web page and shall only  
4 be available to a member of the public by a search using the specific online identifier to determine if  
5 a match exists with a registered offender.

6 5. Juveniles required to register under subdivision (5) of subsection 1 of section 589.400  
7 shall be exempt from public notification to include any adjudications from another state, territory,  
8 the District of Columbia, or foreign country or any federal, tribal, or military jurisdiction."; and

10 Further amend said bill and page, Section 570.212, Line 11, by inserting after said section and line  
11 the following:

13 "589.437. 1. For purposes of this section and section 43.650, the following persons shall be  
14 known as violent offenders:

15 (1) Any person who is on probation or parole for:

16 (a) The offense of murder in the first degree under section 565.020;

17 (b) The offense of murder in the second degree under section 565.021; or

18 (c) An offense in a jurisdiction outside of this state that would qualify under paragraph (a)  
19 or (b) of this subdivision if the offense were to have been committed in this state; and

20 (2) Any person who was found not guilty by reason of mental disease or defect of an offense  
21 listed under subdivision (1) of this subsection.

22 2. The division of probation and parole of the department of corrections, or the department  
23 of mental health if the person qualifies as a violent offender under subdivision (2) of subsection 1 of  
24 this section, shall notify the Missouri state highway patrol if a violent offender is placed on  
25 probation or parole, is placed on conditional release, is removed from probation or parole, or  
26 relocates to this state under the interstate compact for adult offender supervision, sections 589.500 to  
27 589.569, so that the Missouri state highway patrol can update the offender registry under section  
28 43.650."; and

30 Further amend said bill by amending the title, enacting clause, and intersectional references  
31 accordingly.
