Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill No. 756, Page 13, Section 393.1400, Line 95,

2 by inserting after "purposes." the following: "For each
 3 project in the specific capital investment plan on which
 4 construction commences on or after January first of the year
 5 in which the plan is submitted, and where the cost of the
 6 project is estimated to exceed twenty million dollars, the
 7 electrical corporation shall identify all costs and benefits
 8 that can be quantitatively evaluated and shall further
 9 identify how those costs and benefits are quantified. For
 10 any cost or benefit with respect to such a project that the
 11 electrical corporation believes cannot be quantitatively
 12 evaluated, the electrical corporation shall state the
 13 reasons the cost or benefit cannot be quantitatively
 14 evaluated, and how the electrical corporation addresses such
 15 costs and benefits when reviewing and deciding to pursue
 16 such a project. No such project shall be based solely on
 17 costs and benefits that the electrical corporation believes
 18 cannot be quantitatively evaluated. Any quantification for
 19 such a project that does not produce quantified benefits
 20 exceeding the costs shall be accompanied by additional
 21 justification in support of the project."; and

22 Further amend said bill and section, page 14, line 152,
 23 by inserting after "year" the following: ", the
 24 quantitatively evaluated benefits and costs generated by
 25 each of those investments that exceeded twenty million

26 dollars, and any efficiencies achieved as a result of those
27 investments"; and

28 Further amend said bill, page 17, section 393.1640,
29 line 49, by inserting after all of said line the following:
30 "For the purposes of this section, the variable cost to
31 serve new load for purposes of establishing a discount under
32 this section shall be determined using (a) the energy and
33 capacity market prices that underlie the net base energy
34 costs reflected in the revenue requirement from the
35 electrical corporation's most recent general rate
36 proceeding, and (b) any operations and maintenance expenses
37 that vary with respect to the total number of customers or
38 load served by the electrical corporation, excluding
39 operations and maintenance expenses associated with
40 generating electricity."; and

41 Further amend said bill and section, page 20, line 142,
42 by striking "or fifty-five".
