Amend SS/SCS/Senate Bill Nos. 775, 751, & 640, Page 6, Section 566.155, Line 20,

2 by inserting after all of said line the following:

3 "573.550. 1. A person commits the offense of
 4 providing obscene material to a student if such person is
 5 affiliated with a public or private elementary or secondary
 6 school in an official capacity and, knowing of its content
 7 and character, such person provides, assigns, supplies,
 8 distributes, loans, or coerces acceptance of or approving of
 9 the providing of obscene material to a student or possesses
 10 with the purpose of providing, assigning, supplying,
 11 distributing, loaning, or coercing acceptance of or
 12 approving of the providing of obscene material to a student.

13 2. The offense of providing obscene material to a
 14 student is a class A misdemeanor.

15 3. As used in this section, the following terms shall
 16 mean:

17 (1) "Person affiliated with a public or private
 18 elementary or secondary school in an official capacity", an
 19 administrator, teacher, librarian, media center personnel,
 20 substitute teacher, teacher's assistant, student teacher,
 21 law enforcement officer, school board member, school bus
 22 driver, guidance counselor, coach, guest lecturer, guest
 23 speaker, or other nonschool employee who is invited to
 24 present information to students by a teacher, administrator,
 25 or other school employee. Such term shall not include a
 26 student enrolled in the elementary or secondary school;

27 (2) "Obscene material", any material or performance
28 if, taken as a whole:

29 (a) Applying contemporary community standards, its
30 predominant appeal is to prurient interest in sex;

31 (b) The average person, applying contemporary
32 community standards, would find the material depicts or
33 describes sexual conduct in a patently offensive way; and

34 (c) A reasonable person would find the material lacks
35 serious literary, artistic, political, or scientific
36 value."; and

37 Further amend the title and enacting clause accordingly.
