HB 1576 -- REQUIRED IMMUNIZATION LIABILITY ACT

SPONSOR: Wiemann

This bill establishes the "Required Immunization Liability Act" and states that if an employer requires its employees to receive a vaccination as a condition of employment, the employer is liable for damages or injury that arise from such requirement.

Nothing in this section prevents an employer from purchasing insurance to protect the employer and the employees from any liability arising from a required immunization.

This bill is the same as HB 1692 (2022).
