HB 1594 -- MOTOR FUEL

SPONSOR: Walsh (50)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Special Committee on Government Oversight by a vote of 8 to 2.

Currently, an additional tax on motor fuel began with 2.5 cents in October 2021, and will increase by 2.5 cents in each fiscal year until reaching an additional 12.5 cents per gallon on July 1, 2025.

This bill repeals this and the subsequent motor fuel tax increases in current law along with the tax exemption for the motor fuel and the refund associated with the exemption.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill will give citizens relieve at the gas pump since they are already dealing with the impact of inflation. There are other funds that can be utilized to improved the infrastructure. The current statute has an impractical record keeping component and may have been implemented in violation of the Constitution.
