ASSUMPTION

In response to similar legislation from 2021, HB 972, officials from **Office of the State Courts Administrator (OSCA)** assumed there may be some impact but there is no way to quantify that currently. Any significant changes will be reflected in future budget requests.

Oversight does not have information to the contrary and therefore, Oversight will reflect a \$0 fiscal impact for this proposal. Oversight assumes OSCA will be able to administer these requests with existing resources.

Officials from the **Department of Public Safety's Director's Office** and the **Missouri Highway Patrol** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary.
