HB 1951 -- FOOD DELIVERY PLATFORM DRIVERS

SPONSOR: Mackey

A food delivery platform, as defined in the bill, shall not allow an individual to serve as it's driver, until the individual provides proof of motor vehicle insurance coverage under Chapter 303, RSMo, for his or her personal vehicle, that is used to fulfill orders through the food delivery platform. Self-attestation by the individual does not serve as proof of financial responsibility.

The bill provides for the food delivery platform to regularly verify, at least every six months, that the driver it pays is in compliance with the motor vehicle insurance coverage requirements.
