HB 2147 -- SALES TAX FOR FIRE PROTECTION

SPONSOR: Schwadron

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Local Government by a vote of 10 to 0.

This bill adds municipalities contracting for fire protection services to the list of political subdivisions authorized to impose, upon voter approval, a sales tax in an amount of up to .5% for fire protection services.

This bill is similar to HB 1386 (2021).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that these municipalities should be on equal ground with municipalities that have their own fire departments.

Testifying for the bill were Representative Schwadron; David Stokes, Show-Me Institute; Robert Shelton, City of Town and Country; and Municipal League Metro St. Louis.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill say that it is just another tax and there are enough taxes already.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie C. AC Dienoff.
