HB 2172 -- TAX CREDITS

SPONSOR: Francis

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Agriculture Policy by a vote of 17 to 0.

Currently, the Agricultural Product Utilization Contributor Tax Credit under Section 348.430, RSMo, and the New Generation Cooperative Incentive Tax Credit under Section 348.432 expired on December 31, 2021.

This bill moves the expiration date to December 31, 2028.

This bill is similar to HB 693 (2021).

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that the tax credits affected by this bill have helped spur growth in agricultural products throughout the state and support job creation and retention in the industry. The tax credits have helped farmers retain ownership of their products longer and add value to those products.
