

HB 2291 -- PUBLIC SAFETY SALES TAX

SPONSOR: Reedy

This bill authorizes certain cities, upon voter approval, to impose a sales tax of up to 0.5% on all retail sales for the purpose of improving public safety, including but not limited to expenditures on equipment, city employee salaries and benefits, and facilities for police, fire and emergency medical providers.

Upon enactment, this authorization will include the cities of Clinton and Lincoln.

This bill is the same as SB 743 (2022).
