

HB 2425 -- ESCAPE OR ATTEMPTED ESCAPE

SPONSOR: Rogers

This bill removes "for any crime" and "for any offense" such that, now, the offense of escape or attempted escape from custody and the offense of escape or attempted escape from confinement apply to escapes or attempted escapes from custody or confinement, respectively, after arrest without being attached to a crime or offense.

This bill is the same as HB 1958 (2022)
