HB 2475 -- MEMORIAL BRIDGE

SPONSOR: Stephens (128)

COMMITTEE ACTION: Voted "Do Pass" by the Standing Committee on Veterans by a vote of 12 to 0.

That part of the bridge on State Highway P crossing over Lindley Creek in Polk County will be designated the "WWII Henry Archie Black Memorial Bridge".

The Department of Transportation will erect and maintain appropriate signage, with the costs to be paid by private donations.

PROPONENTS: Supporters say that this bill would designate a bridge in Polk County for Henry Archie Black who died in Europe during World War II and is a relative of Representative John Black. The location of the bridge is a fitting location considering the grave of Henry Archie Black is very close to the bridge.

Testifying for the bill was Representative Stephens.

OPPONENTS: Those who oppose the bill submitted online testimony.

Testifying against the bill was Arnie Dienoff.
