FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Department of Revenue (DOR)** assume the following regarding this proposal:

Administrative Impact

§307.350 requires that "any vehicle manufactured as an even-numbered model year shall be inspected and approved pursuant to the safety inspection program established pursuant to §§304.350 to 307.390 in each even-numbered calendar year and any such vehicle manufactured as an odd-numbered model year vehicle shall be inspected and approved pursuant to §§307.350 to 307.390 in each odd-numbered year." §643.315 requires the same for emissions inspections. Revisions are needed to this section.

Until these revisions are made, the Department is unable to provide a fiscal estimate.

DOR states they are unable to provide the fiscal impact of this proposal due to conflicts in statute regarding safety inspections for vehicles in even/odd years; however, **Oversight** does not anticipate there being a significant fiscal impact to DOR based on when a motor vehicle is registered (even vs. odd year). Oversight assumes this allows some level of flexibility to DOR and vehicle owners. Therefore, Oversight will not reflect a fiscal impact to DOR on this fiscal note.

Officials from the **Missouri Highway Patrol** and **Department of Natural Resources** each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. **Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the **Missouri Department of Transportation** defer to the DOR for the potential fiscal impact of this proposal.
