

HB 2666 -- CARRYING OF CONCEALED FIREARMS

SPONSOR: Coleman (97)

This bill makes changes to the locations an individual may carry a concealed firearm within the state and locations an individual with a concealed carry permit may carry a concealed firearm within the state.

This bill also prohibits the state, counties, cities, towns, villages, municipalities, or other political subdivisions of the state from imposing any rule, policy, ordinance, contractual requirement, or agreement of any type that prohibits any employee of such entities who holds a concealed carry permit from carrying a concealed weapon in any area where concealed carry is not otherwise prohibited by law. No institution of higher education may impose as any contractual requirement or condition of employment a prohibition on the lawful possession or carry of firearms.

No changes have been made to the penalties for carrying a concealed firearm in locations prohibited under these provisions.

This bill is similar to HB 1638 (2020).
