Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Officials from the City of Kansas City, the City of St. Louis, the City of Springfield, the Jackson County Board of Elections, the Kansas City Board of Elections, the Platte County Board of Elections, the St. Louis County Board of Elections, Clinton County, the Metropolitan St. Louis Sewer District, the Morgan County PWSD #2 and the Wayne County PWSD #2 each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

In response to similar legislation from this year, HB 2391, officials from Clarence Water/Wastewater, Hughesville Water/Wastewater, the Little Blue Valley Sewer District and the South River Drainage District each assumed the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note for these agencies.

Oversight only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other cities, local election authorities, counties and utility agencies were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
