FISCAL ANALYSIS

ASSUMPTION

Officials from the **Missouri Senate** anticipate a negative fiscal impact to reimburse 10 members of the General Assembly for travel to joint committee meetings. In Summary, it will cost approximately \$1,294 per meeting.

Officials from the **Missouri House of Representatives (MHR)** assume no fiscal impact. Since this is a joint committee we assume the joint contingent appropriation will reimburse our members for any reasonable expenses incurred serving on the committee. We defer to the Senate on the impact to the joint contingent appropriation. The House also assumes that it is not responsible for expenses of the commissioners since the legislation does not clarify.

Oversight assumes the proposal would not have a material direct fiscal impact on the state if a convention is called. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact on the fiscal note.

No direct fiscal impact to small businesses would be expected as a result of this proposal.


FISCAL DESCRIPTION

The proposed legislation appears to have no direct fiscal impact.


This legislation is not federally mandated, would not duplicate any other program and would not require additional capital improvements or rental space.
