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## **FISCAL ANALYSIS**

#### **ASSUMPTION**

§§589.401 and 589.414 – Sexual offender registry

Officials from the **Office of Attorney General (AGO)** assume any additional litigation costs arising from this proposal can be absorbed with existing personnel and resources. However, the AGO may seek additional appropriations if there is a significant increase in litigation or investigation costs.

**Oversight** does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight assumes the AGO will be able to perform any additional duties required by this proposal with current staff and resources and will reflect no fiscal impact to the AGO for fiscal note purposes.

Officials from the Missouri Highway Patrol, the Department of Elementary and Secondary Education, the Department of Natural Resources, the Department of Corrections, the Department of Public Safety – Capitol Police, the Department of Social Services, the Missouri Department of Conservation, the Office of the State Public Defender, the Missouri Office of Prosecution Services, the Branson Police Department, the Kansas City Police Department, the St. Louis County Police Department and the Phelps County Sheriff's Department each assume the proposal will have no fiscal impact on their respective organizations. Oversight does not have any information to the contrary. Therefore, Oversight will reflect a zero impact in the fiscal note.

Officials from the **Office of the State Courts Administrator** did not respond to **Oversight's** request for fiscal impact for this proposal.

**Oversight** only reflects the responses received from state agencies and political subdivisions; however, other local law enforcement and schools were requested to respond to this proposed legislation but did not.
