AN ACT

To repeal section 563.074, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to immunity for defending a person's property.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 563.074, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 563.074, to read as follows:

- 563.074. 1. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 563.016, a person who 2 uses force as described in sections 563.031, [563.041,] 563.046, 563.051, 563.056, and 563.061 is justified in using such force and such fact shall be an absolute defense to criminal prosecution or civil liability.
- [2.] (2) The court shall award attorney's fees, court costs, and all reasonable expenses 6 incurred by the defendant in defense of any civil action brought by a plaintiff if the court finds that the defendant has an absolute defense as provided in **subdivision (1) of this** subsection [4] of this section].
 - 2. (1) Notwithstanding the provisions of section 563.016, a person who uses force as described in section 563.041 is justified in using such force and is immune from criminal prosecution and civil action for the use of such force.
 - The court shall award attorney's fees, court costs, and all reasonable expenses incurred by the defendant in defense of any civil action brought by a plaintiff or in any criminal prosecution if the court finds that the defendant is immune as provided in subdivision (1) of this subsection.
