## AN ACT

To repeal section 575.353, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof two new sections relating to offenses against police animals, with penalty provisions.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 575.353, RSMo, is repealed and two new sections enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as sections 575.352 and 575.353, to read as follows:

575.352. 1. A person commits the offense of killing a police animal if the person intentionally targets and kills a police animal while the animal is in the performance of its duties.

- 2. The offense of killing a police animal is a class A felony.
- 575.353. 1. A person commits the offense of assault on a police animal if he or she
- 2 knowingly attempts to kill or disable or knowingly causes or attempts to cause serious
- 3 physical injury to a police animal when that animal is involved in law enforcement
- 4 investigation, apprehension, tracking, or search, or the animal is in the custody of or under the
- 5 control of a law enforcement officer, department of corrections officer, municipal police
- 6 department, fire department or a rescue unit or agency.
- 7 2. The offense of assault on a police animal is a class [C] A misdemeanor, unless the
- 8 assault results in the death of such animal or disables such animal to the extent it is unable to
- 9 be utilized as a police animal, in which case it is a class [E] **B** felony.
