## AN ACT

To amend chapter 26, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to state agency requirements.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 26, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 26.850, to read as follows:

26.850. 1. On and after January 1, 2019, all executive state agencies and departments shall publish on such state agency's or department's public website all current advisories, applications, announcements, decisions, directories, disclosures, findings, forms, newsletters, notices, orders, opinions, pamphlets, policies, regulations, reports, warnings, and other public information that the agency or department publishes in a physical format. This subsection shall not apply to any confidential or personal information, letters, notices, or petitions the agency or department issues to a specific individual or individuals.

9 2. On and after January 1, 2019, all executive state agencies and departments shall 10 establish features on the agency's or department's public website that allow persons to 11 electronically:

12 (1) Contact the agency or department in response to any communication initiated13 by the department;

- 14 (2) Make contact with the agency or department;
- 15 (3) Submit applications, documents, forms, registrations, or other information; and
- 16 (4) Submit payments.
