AN ACT

To repeal section 21.110, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the issuance of writs of election.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 21.110, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 21.110, to read as follows:

21.110. If the governor receives any resignation or notice of vacancy, or if he **or she** is satisfied of the death of any member of either house, during the recess, he **or she** shall, [without delay] **no later than thirty days from the day that such resignation becomes effective or he or she receives a notice of vacancy**, issue a writ of election to supply the vacancy, **unless such a vacancy occurs within six months of the general election for the ensuing term or the next general election.**
