AN ACT

To repeal section 173.040, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to higher education reports.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 173.040, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 173.040, to read as follows:

173.040. **1.** The coordinating board is directed to submit a written report to the governor or governor-elect at least forty-five days prior to the opening of each regular session of the general assembly and to submit the same report to the general assembly within five days after the opening of each regular session.

- **2.** The report shall include:
- 6 (1) A statement of the initial coordinated plan for higher education in Missouri, 7 together with subsequent changes and implementations;
- 8 (2) A review of recent changes in enrollments and programs among institutions of 9 higher education in the state;
- 10 (3) A review of requests and recommendations made by the coordinating board to 11 institutions of higher education in accordance with section 173.030 and of the college's or 12 university's response to requests and recommendations, including noncompliance therewith;
- 13 (4) The coordinating board's recommendations for development and coordination in 14 state-supported higher education in the forthcoming biennium, within the context of the long-15 range coordinated plan;
- 16 (5) The coordinating board's budget recommendations for each state-supported college or university for the forthcoming biennium; [and]

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

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18 (6) The campus-level data on student persistence and a description, including the basis of measurement, of progress towards implementing revised remediation, transfer, and 20 retention practices under subdivisions (7) and (9) of subsection 2 of section 173.005; and

(7) For each scholarship or grant program funded in any amount by this state, the demographics of all students participating in each such scholarship or grant program including, but not limited to, gender, race, family income level, and number of years of participation in the scholarship or grant program.

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
