## AN ACT

To amend chapter 21, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to senators who represent Missouri in the United States Senate.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 21, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 21.438, to read as follows:

**21.438. 1. Each senator who represents Missouri in the United States Senate shall,  
2 from time to time, appear before the general assembly of this state to provide information  
3 on the activities of the federal government and the interaction of federal law with the laws  
4 and constitution of this state. The senator shall also act on the general assembly's  
5 recommendations regarding measures or acts it deems necessary and expedient to serve  
6 the best interests of Missouri.**

**7 2. The general assembly, acting as a committee as a whole, may enforce the  
8 provisions of this section by subpoena under its rules and procedures on any occasion in  
9 which a senator who represents Missouri in the United States Senate has failed to appear  
10 before the general assembly for an unreasonable period of time.**
