## AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to youth hunting.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be  
2 known as section 252.046, to read as follows:

2 **252.046. Any person six years of age or older and under fifteen years of age,**  
3 **possessing a valid hunting permit, shall hunt in the immediate presence of an adult hunter**  
4 **who is eighteen years of age or older and has in his or her possession a valid hunter**  
5 **education certificate card, if he or she is required to possess such card. Any such adult**  
6 **hunter shall not be required to possess a hunting permit while accompanying such youth**  
6 **hunter.**
