# AN ACT

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to youth hunting.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 252.046, to read as follows:

known as section 252.046, to read as follows:

252.046. Any person six years of age or older and under sixteen years of age,

possessing a valid hunting permit but who has not completed hunter education

3 certification, shall hunt in the immediate presence of an adult who is eighteen years of age

or older and has in his or her possession a valid hunter education certificate card, if he or

5 she is required to possess such card. Any such adult hunter shall not be required to possess

6 a hunting permit while accompanying such youth hunter.
