AN ACT

To amend chapter 544, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to warrantless searches based on the odor of marijuana.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 544, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 544.186, to read as follows:

544.186. Notwithstanding any provision of law, the odor of marijuana alone shall
2 **not provide a law enforcement officer with probable cause to conduct a warrantless**
3 **search of a motor vehicle, home, or other private property.**
