AN ACT

To amend chapter 644, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to agricultural stormwater discharge.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 644, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 644.059, to read as follows:

agriculture shall be exempt from the permit requirements of sections 644.006 to 644.141.

Agricultural stormwater discharges and return flows from irrigated agriculture shall not be considered unlawful under subdivision (1) or (2) of subsection 1 of section 644.051, unless those discharges or return flows have entered waters of the state and have rendered such waters harmful, detrimental, or injurious to public health, safety, or welfare, to industrial or agricultural uses, or to wild animals, birds, fish, or other aquatic life. For the purposes of this section, agricultural stormwater discharges and return flows from

- 9 irrigated agriculture shall include stormwater and snow melt runoff, drainage, and 0 infiltration, including water that leaves land as a result of the application of irrigation
- 10 Inflitration, including water that leaves land as a result of the application of irrigation 11 water, both surface and subsurface, from standard farming industry practices. This shall
- 12 include, but not be limited to, cultivation and tillage of soil, and production, growing,
- 12 raising and harvesting of agricultural commodities and livesteel. Nothing in this section
- 13 raising, and harvesting of agricultural commodities and livestock. Nothing in this section
- 14 shall be construed to effect, limit, or supersede sections 640.700 to 640.755 or any other law
- 15 or regulation of concentrated animal feeding operations.
