AN ACT

To amend chapter 34, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to the state technology modernization fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 34, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 34.625, to read as follows:

**34.625. 1. Any department or agency of the state having any unexpended state
2 general revenue or other eligible funds at the end of the fiscal year may request the state
3 treasurer to deposit such funds into the state technology modernization fund established
4 pursuant to this section.**

**5 2. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "State Technology
6 Modernization Fund", which shall consist of moneys deposited under this section. The
7 state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and
8 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund
9 and moneys in the fund shall be used solely by the department that requested funds be
10 deposited into it for the purpose of making modernized technology purchases. The state
11 treasurer shall invest moneys in the fund in the same manner as other funds are invested.**

**12 3. Any department or agency of the state that has requested unexpended state funds
13 to be deposited into the state technology modernization fund pursuant to this section may
14 collaborate with another department or agency of the state for the purpose of making
15 modernized technology purchases that will be shared by such departments or agencies.**

**16 4. Any funds deposited into the state technology modernization fund that are not
17 expended by a department or agency within three years of deposit shall revert to general
18 revenue.**

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

19 **5. For purposes of this section, the following terms mean:**

20 **(1) "Cloud computing service", a service that enables ubiquitous, convenient,**
21 **on-demand network access to a shared pool of configurable computing resources and can**
22 **be rapidly provisioned and released with minimal management effort or service provider**
23 **interaction;**

24 **(2) "Modernized technology purchase", any purchase of technology whose primary**
25 **purpose is to update hardware or software, promote government efficiency through shared**
26 **services among state departments or state agencies, or enhance cloud computing services.**
