AN ACT

To repeal section 516.371, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the statute of limitation on an action for sexual conduct.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 516.371, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu 2 thereof, to be known as section 516.371, to read as follows:

516.371. Notwithstanding any provision of law to the contrary, there shall be a ten-2 year statute of limitation on any action for damages for personal injury caused to an

3 individual eighteen years of age or older by a person [within the third degree of affinity or

4 consanguinity] who subjects such individual to sexual [contact] conduct, as defined in

5 section 566.010.
