AN ACT

To repeal section 311.735, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to the division of alcohol and tobacco control fund.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 311.735, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 311.735, to read as follows:

311.735. 1. There is hereby created in the state treasury the "Division of Alcohol and Tobacco Control Fund". The state treasurer shall be custodian of the fund. In accordance with sections 30.170 and 30.180, the state treasurer may approve disbursements. The fund shall be a dedicated fund and, upon appropriation, money in the fund shall be used solely by the division of alcohol and tobacco control for the administration, [of this chapter and] **implementation, and enforcement of** sections 407.925 to 407.934, and any duties under such [chapter and] sections relating to licensing, training, technical assistance, and regulations **needed for administering, implementing, and enforcing such sections.**

2. Notwithstanding the provisions of section 33.080 to the contrary, any moneys remaining in the fund at the end of the biennium shall not revert to the credit of the general revenue fund.

3. Appropriation of funds by the general assembly from the fund shall be used to support the division of alcohol and tobacco control for the purposes provided under subsection 1 of this section.
