## AN ACT

To repeal section 217.185, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to reports made by correctional centers.

---

*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Section 217.185, RSMo, is repealed and one new section enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 217.185, to read as follows:

217.185. **1.** The chief administrative officer of each correctional center shall make monthly reports to the appropriate division director of the previous month's activities, which shall include:

- 4 (1) A report of all admissions to and discharges from his correctional center;
- 5 (2) A report of all assaults, deaths, and escapes from his correctional center;
- 6 (3) A report of all complaints filed with the chief administrative officer of the
- 7 correctional center; ~~and~~
- 8 (4) **A report of all misdemeanor and felony offense charges or convictions**
- 9 **committed within the correctional center by or against an employee of the correctional**
- 10 **center or an inmate. The department shall make such report public by posting the report**
- 11 **on its internet website; and**
- 12 (5) Any other information requested by the division director.

13 **2. By December 31, 2018, and each year thereafter, the chief administrative officer**

14 **of each correctional center shall provide the division director a report of the number of**

15 **charges under subdivision (4) of subsection 1 of this section that resulted in a conviction**

16 **and along with the number of charges that did not result in a conviction.**
