AN ACT

To amend chapter 311, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to temporary retail alcohol licenses.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 311, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be 2 known as section 311.255, to read as follows:

311.255. 1. Notwithstanding any other provision of law to the contrary and subject to the qualifications and limitations provided under this chapter, the supervisor of alcohol and tobacco control may issue a temporary packaged alcohol retail license to holders of a current, valid packaged alcohol retail license in good standing under subsections 1 and 2 of section 311.200 and under section 311.292 when such licensee applies for a license for a new establishment of a similar type under the same ownership.

7 2. The temporary license shall be issued immediately upon receipt, processing, 8 and verification by the division that the licensee meets the temporary license 9 requirements, and shall be effective upon receipt by the licensee. The temporary 10 license will be issued for the period that the request for a new permanent license for the 11 new establishment is under review by the division.

12 3. The temporary license authorized under this section shall be subject to all 13 other provisions under the law, subject to revocation as described under this chapter, 14 and void upon receipt of the permanent license or notice by the division that the 15 temporary license has been revoked.

16 **4.** The division shall promulgate all necessary rules and regulations for the 17 administration of this section. Any rule or portion of a rule, as that term is defined in

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18 section 536.010, that is created under the authority delegated in this section shall

- 19 become effective only if it complies with and is subject to all of the provisions of chapter
- 20 536 and, if applicable, section 536.028. This section and chapter 536 are nonseverable,
- 21 and if any of the powers vested with the general assembly pursuant to chapter 536 to
- 22 review, to delay the effective date, or to disapprove and annul a rule are subsequently
- 23 held unconstitutional, then the grant of rulemaking authority and any rule proposed or

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24 adopted after August 28, 2022, shall be invalid and void.
