AN ACT

To amend chapter 71, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to exercising constitutional rights in public.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 71, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be
2 known as section 71.289, to read as follows:

**71.289. No city, town, or village shall pass or enforce any law, ordinance, or
2 resolution that restricts a person from exercising a right enumerated in Amendment I of
3 the Constitution of the United States while such person is on a public sidewalk, street,
4 avenue, alley, or other public place unless state law authorizes such a restriction.**
