AN ACT

To amend chapter 313, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to state lottery winners.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the state of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 313, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new section, to be known as section 313.303, to read as follows:

313.303. 1. It shall be unlawful for the lottery commission, the state lottery or any employee of the state lottery, or any organization with whom the state has contracted to operate the state lottery or any of that organization's employees to publish the name, address, or any other identifying information of any Missouri resident who claims a lottery prize with a value greater than five million dollars when such person has notified the state lottery in writing when completing his or her prize claim form that he or she does not consent to have such information published. The lottery commission may, however, create an incentive to encourage Missouri resident lottery prize winners to consent to the disclosure of such information.

2. For purposes of this section:

(1) Lottery retailers are not considered contractors who operate the lottery;

(2) The word "publish" means to issue information or material in printed or electronic form for distribution or sale to the public and does not include disclosure for purposes of collecting judgment debts or debts owed to a state agency by a prize winner; and

EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets [thus] in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.

16 **(3) Notwithstanding any timely notification of nonconsent, a prize winner who**
17 **publishes his or her prize information shall be deemed to have given implied consent for**
18 **the state lottery to publish his or her information.**

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
