

# House Concurrent Resolution No. 32

## 100TH GENERAL ASSEMBLY

INTRODUCED BY REPRESENTATIVE POGUE.

1           **WHEREAS**, property taxes unreasonably burden Missouri taxpayers, restrain our state's  
2 economy, and should be eliminated; and

3

4           **WHEREAS**, our statutes are entrenched with property tax provisions; and

5

6           **WHEREAS**, a special session is needed in order to properly vet such matters and reform  
7 our statutes to eliminate property taxes; and

8

9           **WHEREAS**, under Article III, Section 20(b) of the Constitution of Missouri, the General  
10 Assembly may call a special session upon filing a petition with the Secretary of State stating the  
11 purpose for which the session is to be called and signed by three-quarters of the members of the  
12 Senate and three-quarters of the members of the House of Representatives; and

14           **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly should have prior notice of such special session in  
15 order to conduct research and draft legislation; and

16

17           **WHEREAS**, the General Assembly should agree to reconvene in a special session in  
18 September 2019, concurrent with the veto session, in order to explore this issue:

20           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of  
21 Representatives of the One Hundredth General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate  
22 concurring therein, hereby agree to file a joint proclamation calling for a special session of the  
23 General Assembly in September 2019, for the purpose of discussing the abolishment of property  
24 taxes in this state; and

26           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of  
27 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for each  
28 member of the General Assembly.
