1 **WHEREAS**, after the November 2020 election, public confidence in the accuracy of the
2 vote count was low; and

3

4 **WHEREAS**, in some states a final count of votes took many weeks; and

5

6 **WHEREAS**, each state regulates federal elections using vastly different rules involving
7 voter eligibility, voter registration, voter identification, early voting, absentee voting, deadlines
8 for voting, types of ballots and voting machines, and rules for vote counting; and

10 **WHEREAS**, uniform federal election laws would encourage faith in election results:

12 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
13 Representatives of the One Hundred First General Assembly, First Regular Session, the Senate
14 concurring therein, hereby urge Congress to enact standardized voting rules and procedures for
15 all federal offices; and

17 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
18 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for House
19 Speaker Nancy Pelosi, Senate Majority Leader Chuck Schumer, and the members of the Missouri
20 Congressional delegation.
