2 **WHEREAS**, section 173.030 of the Revised Statutes of Missouri describes the
3 process for public colleges and universities to follow when seeking a statewide mission
4 designation; and

5 **WHEREAS**, a college or university must provide the Coordinating Board for Higher
6 Education with particular evidence of the institution's capacity to discharge a statewide
7 mission successfully; and

9 **WHEREAS**, Missouri Southern State University provided the Coordinating Board
10 with the necessary evidence that the University can successfully discharge statewide missions
11 in Health and Life Sciences and in Immersive Learning Experiences; and

13 **WHEREAS**, the Coordinating Board voted to approve the request for such
14 designations on September 13, 2023:

16 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
17 Representatives of the One Hundred Second General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the
18 Senate concurring therein, hereby approve of the statewide mission designations in Health
19 and Life Sciences and in Immersive Learning Experiences approved by the Coordinating
20 Board for Higher Education for Missouri Southern State University; and

22 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of
23 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the
24 Commissioner of Higher Education and the President of Missouri Southern State University.
