1 **WHEREAS**, school counselors are employed in public and private schools to help
2 students reach their full potential; and

4 **WHEREAS**, school counselors are actively committed to helping students explore their
5 abilities, strengths, interests, and talents as these traits relate to career awareness and
6 development; and

8 **WHEREAS**, school counselors help parents focus on ways to further the educational,
9 personal, and social growth of their children; and

11 **WHEREAS**, school counselors work with teachers and other educators to help students
12 explore their potential and set realistic goals for themselves; and

14 **WHEREAS**, school counselors seek to identify and utilize community resources that can
15 enhance and complement comprehensive school counseling programs and help students to
16 become productive members of society; and

18 **WHEREAS**, comprehensive developmental school counseling programs are considered
19 an integral part of the educational process that enables all students to achieve success in school:

21 **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of
22 Representatives of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate
23 concurring therein, hereby proclaim the first full week of February of each year as Missouri
24 School Counseling Week; and
