# HOUSE CONCURRENT RESOLUTION NO. 64

1           **WHEREAS**, the Lambert-St. Louis International Airport is owned by the City of St.  
2 Louis, located upon land owned by St. Louis County, and governed by the Airport  
3 Commission; and  
4

5           **WHEREAS**, the Lambert-St. Louis International Airport is a regional hub of  
6 transportation not just for the City of St. Louis and St. Louis County, but for the entire state of  
7 Missouri and bordering states; and  
8

9           **WHEREAS**, the economic prominence of Lambert-St. Louis International Airport in  
10 the region has deteriorated over the last two decades; and  
11

12           **WHEREAS**, despite at least three separate studies of the governance structure for  
13 Lambert-St. Louis International Airport, the people of the City of St. Louis and the people of  
14 St. Louis County have failed to exercise their joint power under Article VI, Sections 30(a) and  
15 30(b) of the Constitution of Missouri, to petition for a Board of Freeholders to make changes  
16 to the governance structure for the airport:

18           **NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED** that the members of the House of  
19 Representatives of the One Hundred Second General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the  
20 Senate concurring therein, hereby request the residents of the state of Missouri to encourage  
21 their elected leaders in the General Assembly to change the management of the Lambert-St.  
22 Louis International Airport from the City of St. Louis, St. Louis County, and the Airport  
23 Commission to a regionally focused management entity; and

25           **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the Chief Clerk of the Missouri House of  
26 Representatives be instructed to prepare a properly inscribed copy of this resolution for the  
27 City of St. Louis and St. Louis County.
