2	<b>WHEREAS</b> , ensuring the health, safety, and welfare of the citizens of this state is one of the most important duties of Missouri's state government; and
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4 5	<b>WHEREAS</b> , providing public assistance to Missouri's most vulnerable citizens is a vital service provided by our state; and
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7 8	<b>WHEREAS</b> , public assistance programs make up a significant portion of our state's budget every year; and
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10 11	<b>WHEREAS</b> , it is critical that our limited state resources be used in the most effective and efficient manner possible, while providing for the needs of our citizens; and
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13 14 15 16	<b>WHEREAS</b> , the Department of Social Services is tasked with implementing such public assistance programs as MO HealthNet, Temporary Assistance for Needy Families (TANF), the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP), and child care subsidies, among others; and
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18 19	<b>WHEREAS</b> , it is crucial to determine whether these programs are working effectively, have adequate funding, and are operating in the most efficient way possible:
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21 22 23	<b>NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED</b> that the members of the House of Representatives of the Ninety-ninth General Assembly, Second Regular Session, the Senate concurring therein, hereby establish the Joint Committee on Social Services; and
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25 26	<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the mission of the joint committee on social services is to:
27	(1) Study and review the efficacy and efficiency of public assistance programs in the

28 state including, but not limited to, the electronic benefits transfer program, MO HealthNet,

29 30 31	temporary assistance for needy families (TANF), the supplemental nutrition assistance program (SNAP), child care subsidies, and other public assistance programs operated by the Department of Social Services;
32 33	(2) Determine the level and adequacy of resources needed for such public assistance programs within the state; and
34 35 36	(3) Develop recommendations to the General Assembly on public assistance programs within the state and on promoting independence from safety net programs among participants, as appropriate; and
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38 39	<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the joint committee on social services shall consist of the following members:
40 41 42	(1) Two members of the House of Representatives with one member appointed by the Speaker of the House of Representatives and one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the House of Representatives;
43 44	(2) Two members of the Senate with one member appointed by the President Pro Tempore of the Senate and one member appointed by the Minority Leader of the Senate;
45	(3) Two members appointed by the Governor;
46	(4) The director of the Department of Social Services or his or her designee; and
47	(5) One member appointed by the Department of Social Services; and
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49 50 51	<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the Speaker of the House of Representatives shall designate the chair of the joint committee and the President Pro Tempore of the Senate shall designate the vice chair of the joint committee; and
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53 54 55 56	<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the staffs of House Research, Senate Research, and the Joint Committee on Legislative Research shall provide such legal, research, clerical, technical, and bill drafting services as the joint committee may require in the performance of its duties; and
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58 59 60	<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the joint committee, its members, and any staff assigned to the joint committee shall receive reimbursement for actual and necessary expenses incurred in attending meetings of the joint committee or any subcommittee thereof; and
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62 63	<b>BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED</b> that the joint committee shall meet within two months of the adoption of this resolution; and
