JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to Article IV of the Constitution of Missouri, by adopting one new section relating to permissible lobbying activities.

Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next

- 2 following the first Monday in November, 2024, or at a special election to be called by the
- 3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for
- 4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article IV of the Constitution of the state
- 5 of Missouri:

Section A. Article IV, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adopting one new

- 2 section, to be known as Section 55, to read as follows:
 - Section 55. After December 7, 2024, no person serving as an elected official
- 2 under or employed by the executive branch shall act or serve as a paid lobbyist, register
- 3 as a paid lobbyist, solicit contracts with the executive branch entity the person
- 4 previously served, solicit prospective employers or clients to represent as a paid lobbyist
- 5 during the time of such service or employment, or act in such a way that could be
- 6 construed as similar to or the same as the actions of a paid lobbyist until the expiration
- 7 of two calendar years after the official or employee last served or was employed, when
- 8 such service was after December 7, 2024.
