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## JOINT RESOLUTION

Submitting to the qualified voters of Missouri an amendment to Article X of the Constitution of Missouri, by adopting one new section relating to tax exemptions for certain disabled veterans.

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*Be it resolved by the House of Representatives, the Senate concurring therein:*

That at the next general election to be held in the state of Missouri, on Tuesday next  
2 following the first Monday in November, 2026, or at a special election to be called by the  
3 governor for that purpose, there is hereby submitted to the qualified voters of this state, for  
4 adoption or rejection, the following amendment to Article X of the Constitution of the state of  
5 Missouri:

Section A. Article X, Constitution of Missouri, is amended by adopting one new  
2 section, to be known as Section 27, to read as follows:

**Section 27. All real property, personal property, and income of any resident of  
2 this state who is a veteran of the Armed Forces of the United States or the Missouri  
3 National Guard and who has a total service-connected disability, as determined by the  
4 US Department of Veterans Affairs, shall be exempt from real property tax, personal  
5 property tax, and income tax otherwise levied or imposed under the laws of this state.**

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EXPLANATION — Matter enclosed in bold-faced brackets **[thus]** in the above bill is not enacted and is intended to be omitted from the law. Matter in **bold-face** type in the above bill is proposed language.
