2 3 4	WHEREAS, it has come to the attention of the House of Representatives of the Ninety- ninth General Assembly of the State of Missouri that Eric R. Greitens, Governor of the State of Missouri, is alleged to have committed certain acts and omissions which, if true, would constitute grounds for impeachment under the law of Missouri; and
5 6 7	WHEREAS , on March 1, 2018, the Missouri House of Representatives adopted House Resolution 5565 by a unanimous vote; and
8 9 10 11	WHEREAS , H.R. 5565 charged the Special Investigative Committee on Oversight with "investigat[ing] allegations against Governor Eric R. Greitens and report[ing] back to the House of Representatives."; and
12 13 14 15	WHEREAS , on April 11, 2018, the Committee submitted a report, along with transcripts of testimony and exhibits received by the Committee, which consisted of detailed actions taken by the highest official in the state that are disturbing, abusive, and criminal; and
16 17 18 19 20 21	WHEREAS , House Rule 64(3) states that "[a]ny resolution offered to request an investigation of a state official for the purposes of impeachment shall be referred to any committee designated by the Speaker. Articles of impeachment shall only be introduced by the committee designated to investigate the matter and shall be read by title on three separate days."; and
22 23 24 25 26 27	WHEREAS, the Special Investigative Committee on Oversight has investigated allegations related to the actions of Governor Eric R. Greitens and provided sufficient documentation warranting another group of Representatives to investigate whether articles of impeachment should be filed:
