## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 252, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to hunting permits.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 252, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 252.047, to read as
- 3 follows:
  - 252.047. 1. The commission shall not require any
- 2 resident or nonresident landowner, as such terms are defined
- 3 by rules promulgated by the commission, to register the
- 4 landowner's property before receiving any landowner hunting
- 5 permit or to possess any hunting permit to take wildlife on
- 6 the landowner's property. Any existing or future
- 7 requirement for a landowner to register the landowner's
- 8 property to receive any landowner hunting permit is hereby
- 9 void.
- 10 2. The commission shall issue any landowner hunting
- 11 permit requested by any resident or nonresident landowner
- 12 who owns at least five acres of real property and requests
- 13 such landowner hunting permit.
- 14 3. (1) As used in this subsection, the term
- 15 "immediate family member of the landowner" means a
- 16 landowner's spouse, child, stepchild, sibling, stepsibling,
- 17 parent, stepparent, grandparent, grandchild, and any person
- in an adoptive relationship with the landowner.

19	(2) A landowner who qualifies for any landowner
20	hunting permit under this section may request any hunting
21	permit authorizing the taking of wildlife on the landowner's
22	property for a specified two-day period on behalf of one
23	nonresident immediate family member of the landowner. No
24	more than one request shall be made in a calendar year under
25	this subsection.

26 (3) The commission shall issue such hunting permit
27 upon request. Such permit shall be provided free of charge.
