# SENATE BILL NO. 1039

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## AN ACT

To amend chapter 37, RSMo, by adding thereto three new sections relating to the Missouri geospatial advisory council.

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*Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:*

Section A. Chapter 37, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto  
2 three new sections, to be known as sections 37.1300, 37.1310,  
3 and 37.1320, to read as follows:

37.1300. For the purposes of sections 37.1300 to  
2 37.1330, the following terms mean:

3 (1) "Council", the Missouri geospatial advisory  
4 council established in section 37.1310;

5 (2) "Geographic information system (GIS)", a computer  
6 system for capturing, storing, checking, and displaying data  
7 related to positions on the Earth's surface that enables  
8 easily seeing, analyzing, and understanding patterns and  
9 relationships;

10 (3) "Geospatial", relating to or denoting data that is  
11 associated with a particular location;

12 (4) "Missouri Spatial Data Information Service" or  
13 "MSDIS", Missouri's primary spatial data clearinghouse  
14 responsible for collecting and distributing vector data,  
15 aerial photography, and light detection and ranging  
16 elevation data that are generated, updated, and funded by  
17 state, local, and regional agencies and governments.

37.1310. There is hereby established within the office  
2 of administration the "Missouri Geospatial Advisory  
3 Council", which is charged with advising the state in  
4 ensuring the availability, implementation, and enhancement  
5 of a statewide geospatial data infrastructure. The council  
6 shall be established within the office of the commissioner  
7 of administration.

37.1320. 1. The council shall consist of members as  
2 follows:

3 (1) The commissioner of administration, or the  
4 commissioner's designee;

5 (2) The director of the department of agriculture, or  
6 the director's designee;

7 (3) The director of the department of conservation, or  
8 the director's designee;

9 (4) The director of the department of economic  
10 development, or the director's designee;

11 (5) The director of the department of elementary and  
12 secondary education, or the director's designee;

13 (6) The director of the department of health and  
14 senior services, or the director's designee;

15 (7) The director of the department of natural  
16 resources, or the director's designee;

17 (8) The Missouri military advocate, or the advocate's  
18 designee;

19 (9) The adjutant general of the department of the  
20 national guard, or the adjutant general's designee;

21 (10) The director of the department of public safety,  
22 or the director's designee;

23 (11) The director of the department of revenue, or the  
24 director's designee;

- 25           (12) The director of the department of social  
26 services, or the director's designee;
- 27           (13) The director of the department of transportation,  
28 or the director's designee;
- 29           (14) The director of the United States Geological  
30 Survey, or the director's designee;
- 31           (15) The director of the United States Department of  
32 Agriculture - Natural Resource Conservation Service, or the  
33 director's designee;
- 34           (16) The director of the Missouri 911 service board,  
35 or the director's designee;
- 36           (17) The president of the University of Missouri  
37 system, or the president's designee;
- 38           (18) The director of the Missouri Spatial Data  
39 Information Service, or the director's designee;
- 40           (19) The director of the National Geospatial  
41 Intelligence Agency-West, or the director's designee;
- 42           (20) A member of the state senate, appointed by the  
43 president pro tempore of the senate;
- 44           (21) A member of the house of representatives,  
45 appointed by the speaker of the house of representatives;
- 46           (22) Thirteen citizens of Missouri, appointed by the  
47 commissioner of administration. Such individuals shall  
48 represent a geographic balance from within the state,  
49 representing both rural and urban areas with at least one  
50 individual from each of the seven Missouri economic  
51 development regions, as determined by the Missouri economic  
52 research information center. Such individuals shall  
53 additionally represent city, county, and local government;  
54 the private sector; public safety; and academia; and
- 55           (23) Additional subject matter experts may participate  
56 in activities as non-council members.

57           2. Appointed members of the council shall serve three-  
58 year terms and shall serve until their successors are  
59 appointed. Vacancies on the council shall be filled in the  
60 same manner as the original appointment and such member  
61 appointed shall serve the remainder of the unexpired term.

62           3. The council shall meet monthly and as otherwise  
63 required by the commissioner of the office of administration.

64           4. The council shall designate from its members a  
65 chair and chair-elect for one-year terms and shall adopt  
66 written guidelines to govern the management of the council.

67           5. Each member of the council shall serve without  
68 compensation but may be reimbursed for his or her actual and  
69 necessary expenses incurred in the performance of his or her  
70 duties as a member of the council.

71           6. The commissioner of the office of administration  
72 shall designate an employee of the office of administration  
73 as executive secretary for the council, who shall serve as a  
74 nonvoting member and shall maintain the records of the  
75 council's activities and decisions and shall be responsible  
76 for correspondence between the council and other agencies.

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
