## AN ACT

To amend chapter 301, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to motor vehicle history reports.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 301, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 301.574, to read as follows:

301.574. A motor vehicle dealer, as defined in section 301.550, and such dealer's owners, shareholders, officers, employees, and agents who, in conjunction with the actual or potential sale or lease of a motor 4 vehicle, arrange to provide, actually provide, or otherwise make available to a vehicle purchaser, lessee, or other person any third-party motor vehicle history report, shall not be liable to the vehicle purchaser, lessee, or any other person for any errors, omissions, or other inaccuracies contained in the third-party motor vehicle history 9 report that are not based on information provided directly to the preparer of the third-party motor vehicle report by that dealer. As 10 11 used in this section, the term "third-party motor vehicle history report" 12 shall mean any information prepared by a party other than the dealer, 13 relating to any one or more of the following: vehicle ownership or 14 titling history; liens on the vehicle; vehicle service, maintenance, or repair history; vehicle condition; or vehicle accident or collision 16 history.
