## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 191, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to public health.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 191, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 2 one new section, to be known as section 191.1950, to read as
- 3 follows:
  - 191.1950. 1. The chief medical officer of the
- 2 department of health and senior services, the chief medical
- director of the department of mental health, or any licensed
- 4 physician acting with the express written consent of the
- 5 director of the department of health and senior services,
- 6 the director of the department of mental health, or the
- 7 director of the MO HealthNet division within the department
- 8 of social services may issue, within his or her scope of
- 9 practice, the following:
- 10 (1) A nonspecific recommendation of doula services;
- 11 (2) A medical standing order for prenatal vitamins; or
- 12 (3) A medical standing order for any other purpose
- 13 promulgated by rule in compliance with the provisions of
- 14 chapter 536, with the exception of issuing standing orders
- 15 for controlled substances.
- 16 2. Any standing orders issued under the provisions of
- 17 this section shall:
- 18 (1) Be posted on the agency's website while in effect;

- 19 (2) Terminate upon the vacancy of such position by the 20 issuing medical professional; and
- 21 (3) Expire within one year of issuance, unless renewed.
- 22 3. Such chief medical officer or chief medical
- 23 director shall be immune from criminal prosecution,
- 24 disciplinary actions from his or her professional licensing
- 25 board, and civil liability for issuing the standing order or
- 26 recommendation or for any outcome related to the standing
- 27 order or recommendation.
