## **AN ACT**

To amend chapter 167, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to participation of home school students in public school activities.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 167, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto

- 167.790. 1. No school district shall be a member of,
- 2 or remit any funds to a statewide activities association
- 3 that:
- 4 (1) Prohibits a student who is receiving instruction
- 5 at a home school, as defined in section 167.031, from the
- 6 opportunity to participate in any event or activity offered
- 7 by the school district or an attendance center of the school
- 8 district in which the student resides and where the
- 9 statewide activities association exercises authority, rules,
- 10 or guidelines for participating in such events or activities
- 11 for any reason relating to such student's home instruction;
- 12 or
- 13 (2) Requires a student to attend more than one class
- 14 directly related to, and necessary for, participation in an
- 15 event or activity in order to participate in such event or
- 16 activity.
- 17 2. The department of elementary and secondary
- education may withhold payments under section 163.031 for

any district in violation of this section. The department shall release any withheld funds under this section upon the district providing satisfactory proof to the state board of education that the school district has ceased membership in

23 the association and has ceased remission of any funds to

- 3. A statewide activities association shall not prohibit or restrict any school district which is a member of such association from participating in any events sanctioned, authorized, or regulated by such association with any school that is not a member of the association.
- 4. School disciplinary policies shall apply to all participants in events or activities offered by the school district.
- 5. Any records created by a school district or attendance center under this section shall not be disclosed by such district for any purpose.
