AN ACT

To amend chapter 21, RSMo, by adding thereto one new section relating to effects on Missouri in the event of a sudden breakdown in the authority of the federal government, with an emergency clause.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Chapter 21, RSMo, is amended by adding thereto one new 2 section, to be known as section 21.802, to read as follows:

- 21.802. 1. The "Task Force on Government Continuity" is hereby established consisting of the following members:
- 3 (1) Two senators appointed by the president pro tempore of the 4 senate;
- 5 (2) Two representatives appointed by the speaker of the house 6 of representatives;
- 7 (3) The director of the department of homeland security or 8 designee thereof;
- 9 (4) The attorney general or designee thereof;
- 10 (5) The adjutant general or designee thereof; and
- 11 (6) The director of the department of agriculture or designee 12 thereof.
- 13 2. The task force shall be charged with studying the potential
- 14 impacts on Missouri from, and preparation of the government and the
- 15 citizens of Missouri for, a potential disruption of the United States
- 16 federal government including, but not limited to:
- 17 (1) Potential effects of the rapid decline of the United States
- 18 dollar and the ability to quickly provide an alternative currency;
- 19 (2) Potential effects of a situation in which the federal 20 government has no effective power or authority over the people of the

- 21 United States;
- 22 (3) Potential effects of a constitutional crisis;
- 23 (4) Coordination between the governor's office, Missouri national
- 24 guard and any federal military in Missouri;
 - (5) Potential effects of a disruption in food distribution; and
- 26 (6) Potential effects of a disruption in energy distribution.
- 27 3. The task force shall submit a report containing
- 28 recommendations with respect to the issues specified in subsection 2
- 29 of this section to the governor and the general assembly by December
- 30 **1, 2012.**

- 31 4. The members of the task force shall serve without
- 32 compensation but may be reimbursed for travel and other expenses
- 33 actually and necessarily incurred in the performance of their duties by
- 34 the office of administration.

Section B. Because of the need to prepare for the effects on Missouri in

- 2 the event of a sudden breakdown in the authority of the federal government,
- 3 section A of this act is deemed necessary for the immediate preservation of the
- 4 public health, welfare, peace and safety, and is hereby declared to be an
- 5 emergency act within the meaning of the constitution, and section A of this act
- 6 shall be in full force and effect upon its passage and approval.
