AN ACT

To repeal section 301.145, RSMo, and to enact in lieu thereof one new section relating to special license plates.

Be it enacted by the General Assembly of the State of Missouri, as follows:

Section A. Section 301.145, RSMo, is repealed and one new section 2 enacted in lieu thereof to be known as section 301.145 to read as follows:

enacted in lieu thereof, to be known as section 301.145, to read as follows: 301.145. Any person who has been awarded the Congressional Medal of Honor may apply for special motor vehicle license plates for any vehicle he or she owns, either solely or jointly, other than commercial vehicles weighing over twenty-four thousand pounds, as provided in this section. Any such person shall make application for the special license plates on a form provided by the director of revenue and furnish such proof of receipt of the Congressional Medal of Honor as the director may require. The director shall then issue license plates bearing the words "CONGRESSIONAL MEDAL OF HONOR" in a [form] manner prescribed by the [advisory committee established in section 301.129, except that] 10 director of revenue. Such license plates shall be made with fully reflective 11 material with a common color scheme and design, shall be clearly visible at night, and shall be aesthetically attractive, as prescribed by section 301.130. There 12shall be no limit on the number of license plates any person qualified under this 13 section may obtain so long as each set of license plates issued under this section 14 is issued for vehicles owned solely or jointly by such person. License plates 15 issued under this section shall not be transferable to any other person except that 16 any registered co-owner of the motor vehicle may operate the motor vehicle for 17

the duration of the year licensed in the event of the death of the qualified

person. There shall be no fee charged in addition to regular registration
